In the event that the applicant disconnects servicewithin (12) months of Alpine's installation of gas facilities, applicant agrees to pay for such facilities in accordance with the provisions of Alpine's Tariff Rule No. 13, regarding temporary service. A \$30.00 fee to initiate service must accompany this application.
