CALL 811 BEFORE YOU DIG 800-642-2444/811

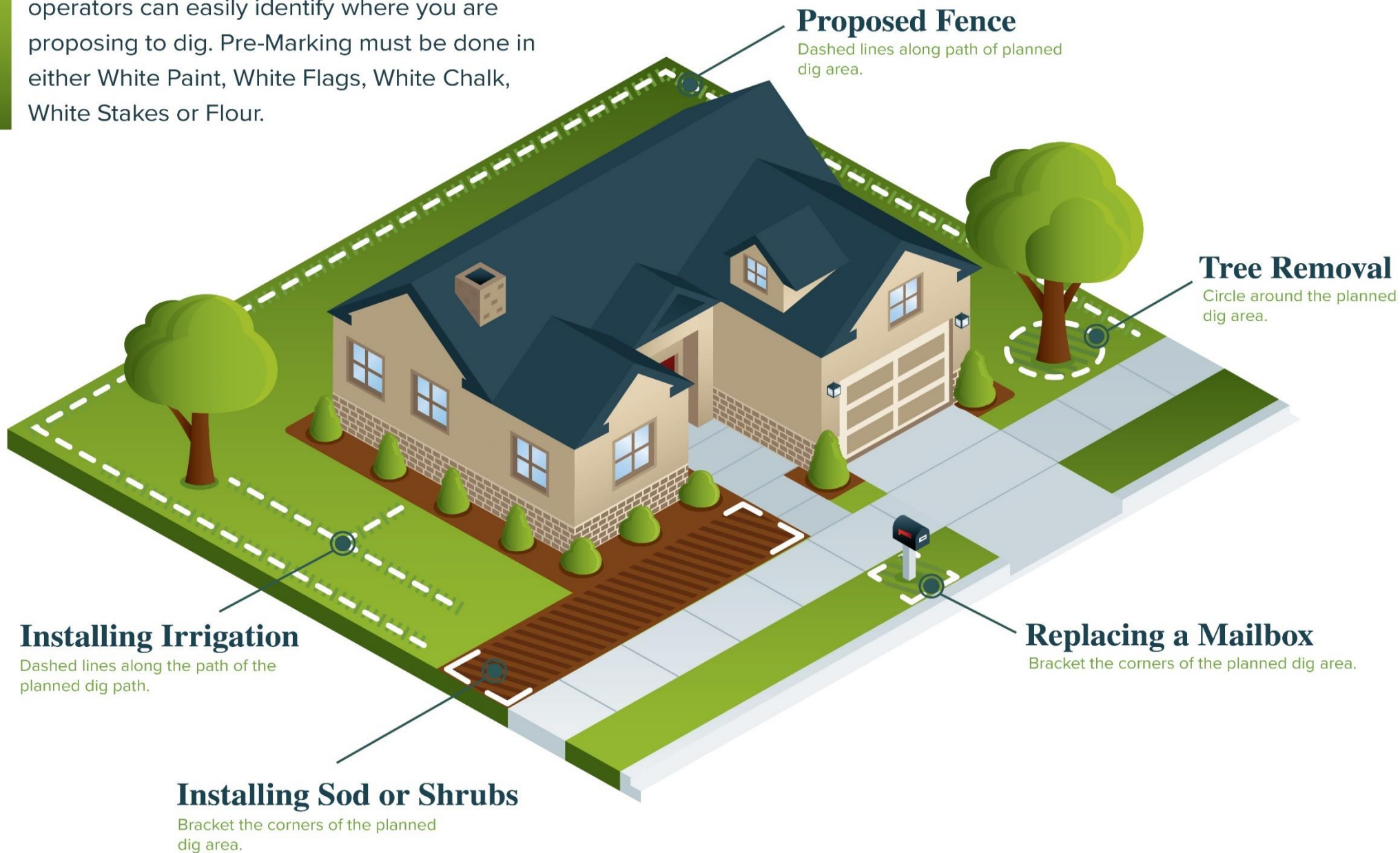
Call before you dig **(811) UNDERGROUND SERVICE ALERT**, it is a free call. It is also the law to call before any digging has begun. An underground gas line is installed on your property, and you must call this number prior to any excavation on your premises. Calling 811 allows Alpine to safely locate and Mark its underground piping so that any excavation can be performed safely.

Pre-Marking outlines your dig area so that utility operators can easily identify where you are proposing to dig. Pre-Marking must be done in either White Paint, White Flags, White Chalk, White Stakes or Flour.



Proposed Fence

Dashed lines along path of planned dig area.

Tree Removal

Circle around the planned dig area.

Installing Irrigation

Dashed lines along the path of the planned dig path.

Replacing a Mailbox

Bracket the corners of the planned dig area.

Installing Sod or Shrubs

Bracket the corners of the planned dig area.
